"Thought short in height & age but we are tall in building image"

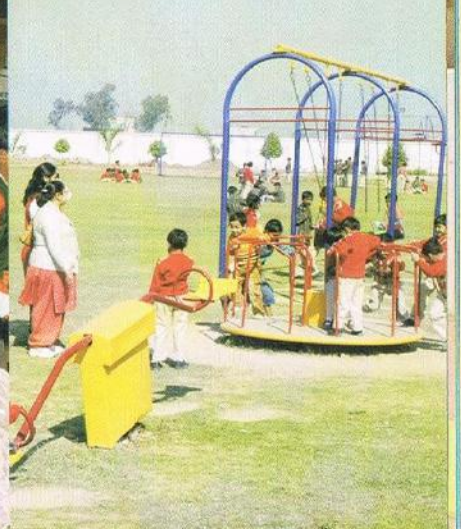
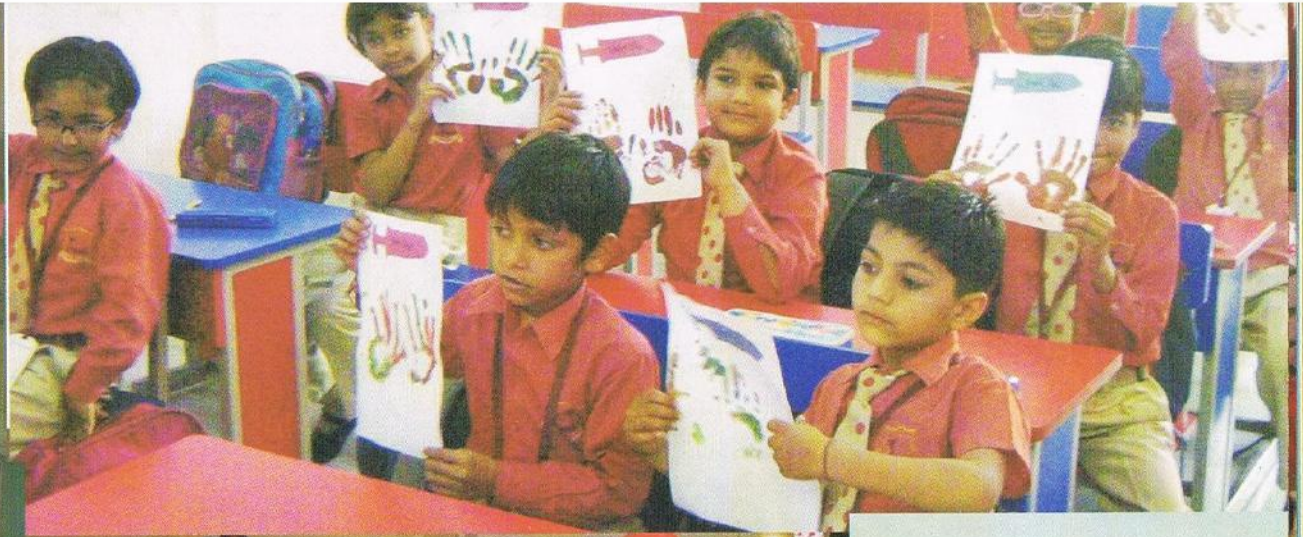
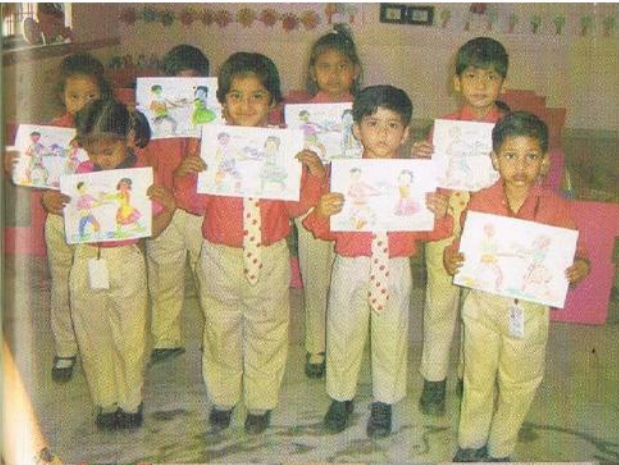

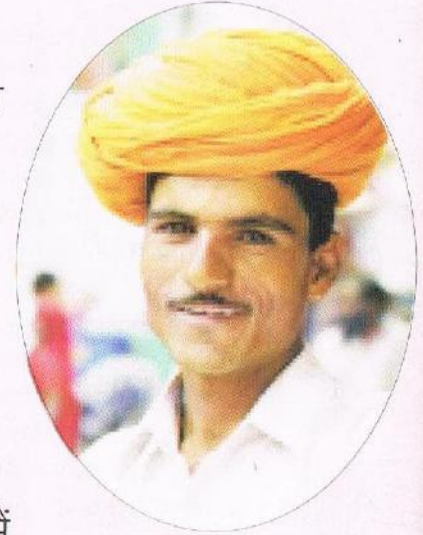
बुद्धिमान ग्रामीण
