ANNUAL REPORT ...

Our system and programs have set the milestones for the quality and achievements for success. The school is continually evolving to meet the growing needs of students by creating new programs for participation and involvement. Mittal International School brings theory to practice through rigorous curricula led by teacher-experts in their fields, providing opportunities for students to excel academically, creatively and professionally and we as a school have so much to celebrate in this area.

There have been so many achievements carved during the academic year 2014-15. Achievers in board exams, selections in competitive exams & Olympiads, our remarkable performances in sports and literary activities all of these are wonderful aspects of our school life.

Beyond all our academic efforts and accomplishments, it is the dignity and the value that supersedes all other aspects, a value which is inherent in our humanity and is expressed most clearly in the choices we make. Today as we stand to complete 8 eventful years, I take the privilege to unfurl the flashes of the past session. The new session commenced on 3rd April 2014 with lots of enthusiasm.

OUTCOMES

The month of May also brought laurels to the school with the declaration of the board results of X and XII. Students who excelled in X with 10 CGPA were Yukti Mittal, Hrishika Kamra, Aayesha Khan & Anukriti Parsoya. Our Mittalites Avani Ahuja and Tiyaasha Mandal cleared MBBS and IIT Entrance Exam respectively and were awarded scholarship of Rs. 80,000 each per year for a span of 5 years by CBSE. Many students saw conspicuous success in our school in all the streams. Sujoy Singh got through in MBBS Entrance Exams. Punit Dhoot and Paras Sipani cleared IIT Entrance Exam got entry into Roorkee IIT & IIT BHU, Varanasi respectively whereas Meena Agarwal cleared NIT Surat. And most importantly a feather in our hat is Abhishek Gupta of class XII who scored 99% in Biology and got Merit Certificate from CBSE and an appreciation letter from HRD Minister Mrs. Smriti Irani.

In July, carrying forward the mantle of leadership an investiture ceremony was conducted on 9th July 2014. Where the institution formally appointed the newly formed school cabinet Sr. Kohinoor head boy Faraz Ali Khan Sr. Kohinoor head girl Rochelle Sharma, Jr. Kohinoor head boy Advait Agarwal & Jr. Kohinoor head girl Venus Jangid and their team. 187 Students participated in the Hindi Rashtra Bhasha Prachar Examination and Alshifa Khan of 8A, Vidhi Gupta of 7B, Faloudeep Gupta of 9B and Saanchi Vijay of grade 2 bagged gold medals.

Students participated in Interschool Debate Competition in English & Hindi organized by Lions Club on Hiroshima Day in which Labhansh Mittal of grade 9B bagged the first position in English & Muskan Agarwal of 9A bagged second position in Hindi debate.

Another Inter school English debate contest was organized by Kota Sahodaya Schools complex on 9th Aug 2014 & Shrishti Mittal bagged the 1st prize. Students of MIS also participated in various quiz contests like Intact Heritage Quiz & Virasat where they secured forth position amongst participating schools. An Inter school quiz contest was organized by Kota Sahodaya School Complex where MIS students bagged the 1st runner up trophy out of 13 participating schools. Various Inter House Quiz contest were held in subjects like Maths & Social studies where the students got an opportunity to show their talents.

MIS also got an opportunity to host the Rotary Youth leadership program

RYLA on 19th Dec 2014. 110 students from various schools of Kota participated in this program. Students were illumined on various aspects of life towards success. The speakers for the event were Mr. Shailendra Maheshwari, Director Career Point, Kota who spoke on Time Management, leadership qualities. Mr. Yogesh Chandak JCI, Zone 5 elaborated on effective communication skills, self confidence, self respect positive thinking & personality development and subsequently Mrs. Sangeeta Kacker that is myself, took a session on "There is a smart child in every child" and highlighted on the fact that every child is gifted in different ways. Questions, video clipping, discussions & games were the highlights of the day.

To sensitize students on our rich Indian culture & heritage all festivals were celebrated in the school. Celebrations were in the form of poster making, Slogan writing, Nukkad Natak, Games, Talk shows, Quiz, Seminars and Cultural events like dance & song. Patriotic events like Independence Day, Republic Day, Gandhi Jayanti were also celebrated. To develop love for our Rashtra bhasha Hindi, a Hasya Kavi Sammelan & Muhavare & Locokti Pratiyogita were held for grade 6 to 10. Community Services were also undertaken by MIS students.

Taking forward the Mission of our Prime Minister 'Swachh Bharat' students of MIS participated in the Railway Station cleanliness drive. They performed Nukkad Natak, wrote slogans & created an awareness in people to keep the Railway platforms clean. A poster making competition was organized by the Railway authorities & Prakrati Jain of 7A bagged 1st position & Oshin Ansari of 8B got 2nd position.



The students of our school motivated them to come to school regularly, explaining the advantages of being educated. Eatables were also distributed to Mother Teresa home.

1. The students celebrated World Earth Day on 22nd April by working on projects preparing posters, writing slogans and participating in Collage making competition on "How To Save Mother Earth".
2. A 'career counseling workshop on Multiple Natures and Multiple Intelligence' was organized on 26th April 2014 for the students of grade 8 to 10, along with their parents. It was an effort made by MIS to give a spark to the students to analyze themselves and move ahead with a goal in their lives.
3. On 28th April there was a Spic Macay programme of Kathak by Ms. Gauri Shankar who depicted the soulful formations and emotions through her performance. The show began with a soulful Sarawati Vandana followed by Teen Taal and various mudras of Kathak. Students were greatly inspired by her enchanting performance.
4. 'International Labour Day' was celebrated on 1st May by MIS students in the form of 'Nukkad Natak' just to promote awareness for the working class, Nukkad Natak is a street play which has been an integral part of Indian tradition.

The school management awards were received by Mrs. Hemlata Lidiya & Mr. Sanjeev Yadav.

SYMPOSIUM ON SUBSTANCE ABUSE



Substance abuse, also known as drug abuse and substance use disorder, is a patterned use of a drug in which the user consumes the substance in amounts or with methods which are harmful to themselves or others, and is a form of substance related disorder.

Drug misuse is a term used commonly when prescription medication with sedative, anxiolytic analgesic or stimulant properties are used for mood alternation or intoxication ignoring the fact that overdose of such medicines have serious adverse effects. Prescription misuse has been defined differently and rather inconsistently based on status of drug prescription, the uses without a prescription, international use to achieve intoxicating effects, route of administration, co-ingestion with alcohol and the presence or absence of dependance symptoms.

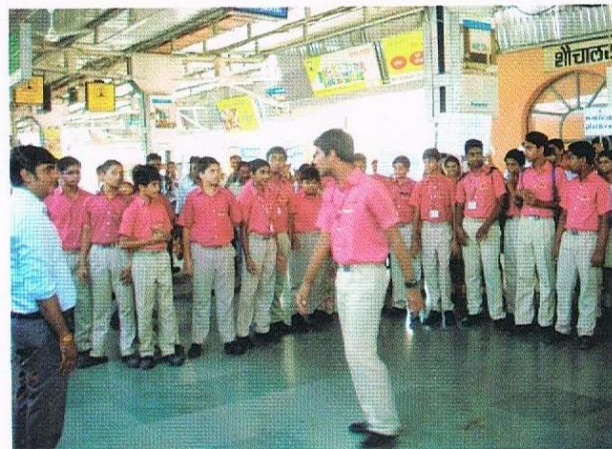
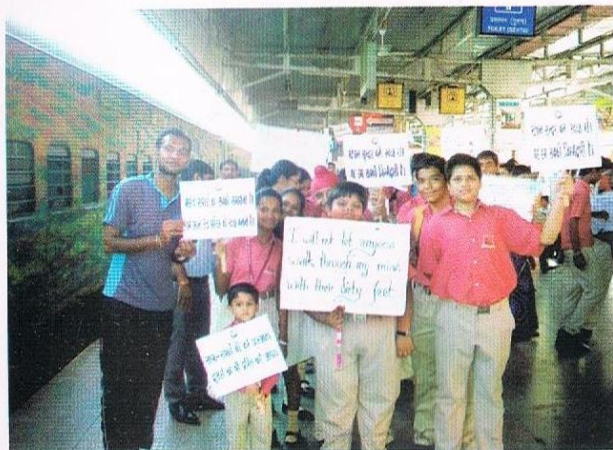

Some of these are often thought of as being abused. Some drugs appear to be more likely to lead to uncontrolled use than others.



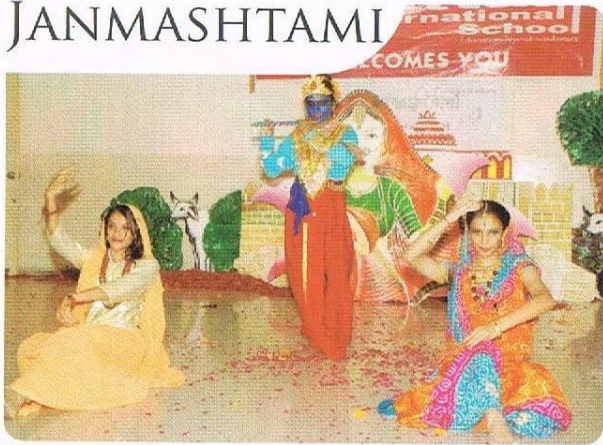

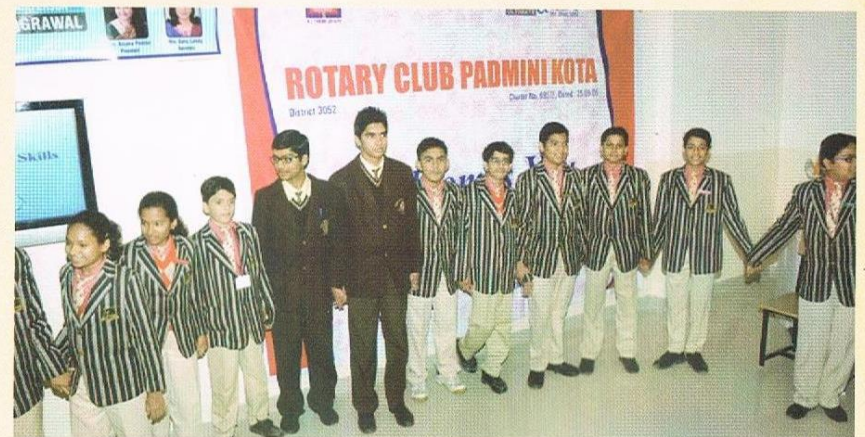
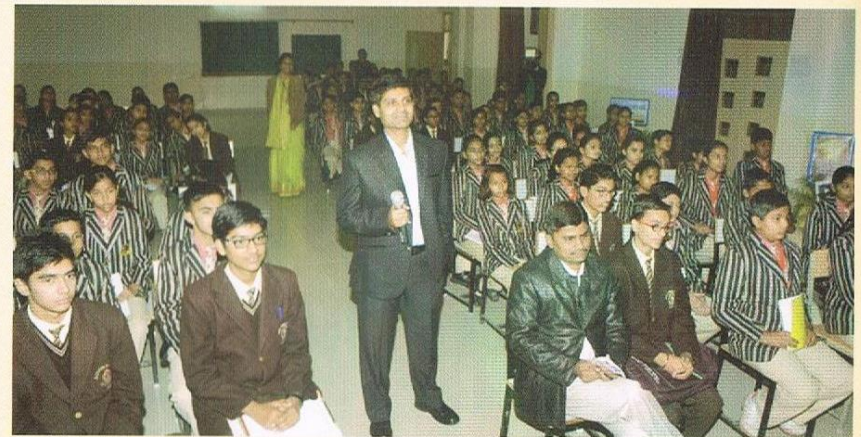
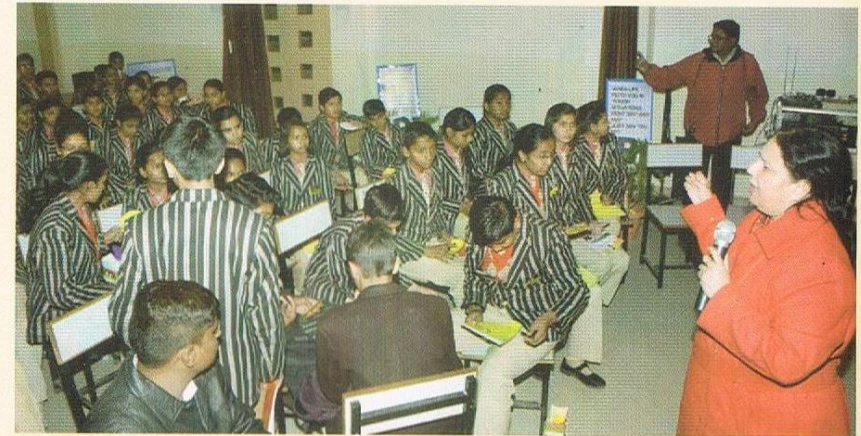




RYLA ROTARY YOUTH LEADERSHIP AWARDS
