The value of Enrichment in children

A common goal for both education and recreation is to enhance the lives of people of all ages. Through recreation individuals can find the motivation to lead a productive life. Enrichment activities can help students generate patterns for creative proficiency, build good character, initiate an engaged mode for learning, and find purpose in life. Enrichment activities generate patterns for creative proficiency? The achievement goal theory is one of the popular approaches to understand what motivates a person. It refers to how students respond or react to an experience and how they achieve goals. These are two significant goal types : task involved and ego-involved. The task-involved good focuses on getting better at something through training and incremental mastery learning. Ego-involved goals strive to be better chance to be aligned with adaptive motivational patterns including such practices as working hard, choosing harder learning tasks and believing that accomplishments are a result of the effort invested. Enrichment activities can be a vehicle to teach the attitude and habits required to do well in other subjects and other areas of life.

When students learn to motivate themselves, discipline their minds, work hard, create and implement their study plans, and seek help when needed, they will be well equipped not only for the challenges in college but for success in future endeavours. Two essential aspects of motivation are the viewpoints about how good one is and how much value one sees in the activity. When individuals feel they can do something well, they invest more effort, energy, and time into their tasks. In the same way, when people feel the activity things value to them, whether the value is in its interest, importance, usefulness, or enjoyment, they persist beyond distraction, difficulties, or obstacles. The challenge for educators is not only to grasp their students attention but see them take initiative. Our educational system focuses on developing knowledge, skills, and creative talents but what about the more fundamental dimension of educating students to grow their empathy, spirituality, and desire to be good. One of my goals for providing enrichment activities is to balance the emphasis of professional abilities with good character traits and moral standards of influence and responsibility. Enrichment activities can be anything from service projects to walks in nature, sports to book reading, hands on projects to research papers, or even wholesome video games or work experience.

Rather than just book learning a particular lesson, students should learn from the entire situation & through doing something in the right way. The reality is that if a student is only given information very little of that knowledge remains with the student. Our goal as teachers is to guide students to become engaged in their learning so they will not only enjoy it more but they will retain the knowledge longer. When doing enrichment activities if the student becomes an instigator which is much more than just a participant motivation, interest & progress multiply naturally

As educators in modern (rather postmodern) period we always emphasize at introducing creative ways of learning to our students. We try to amalgamate traditional forms of learning and new innovative ways of understanding in a manner that we 'facilitate' their gain of knowledge so that our students become self-reliant. I believe that this approach can change our circumstances and what and how the students do affects their future. We often talk about unempolment and related problems but we hardly discuss with our kids the sbundant possibilities that await for them. Our lives are full of opportunities to become self-reliant, and we should be encouraged to go out and make our marks on the worls.

How is education helping our students ti be ready for thier future? There has been a lot of disussion in the last few years about the traditional system of education and whether or not it is doing the job our future needs. The systems in place are not changing as fast as the world around us but innovations are emerging which show great promise. A good example is Sugata Mitra, winner of the TED Prize in Education. He conducted an axperiment by leaving a computer accessible to a population of children livig in extreme poverty in india. eithout any instruction at all they figures out how to use it. They learned Engliss, searched through many websites on their own an d then taught other children. They demonstrated a very powerful human trait, when confronted with a problem, to 'just figure it out'.

We need our future generation out there questioning and learning and pushing the boundaries. Ideal program according to me is to create an individual learning plan for each student that blends traditional instruction, self0 guided study and collaboration with other students and seeing if we could relate or put everything into practice. It knowledge. I always emphasize that leadership and community involvement are as important as other subjects taught in the school. In a world that is changing so fast many of us hardly recognize it, the greatest gift we can give to the future is a self-reliant population who is equipped to learn and grow with their fast paced.
