

Editors' Perception



- 1. सामान्य परिचय :— संगीत की उत्पत्ति के विषय में जितना भी विद्वानों ने कहा है, उससे यही साबित होता है कि जब कुछ भी ना था, तब संगीत तथा और तब से आज तक संगीत है। इस जहाँ में कुछ रहे या ना रहे, संगीत हमेशा रहा था, रहा है और रहेगा। सागर की लहरों, नदियों की धारा, झरने की कलकल, पहाड़ पर्वत, वनों या हम कहें धरती, आकाश—पाताल अर्थात इस ब्रह्माण्ड के कण—कण में संगीत है।
- 2. संगीत क्या है? :- सामान्य शब्दों में गायन, वावन और नृत्य इन तीनों कलाओं के समावेश को संगीत कहते हैं।
- 3. संगीत एक साधना है: संगीत की देवी 'माँ सरस्वती' को माना जाता है। संगीत में सात स्वर होते है—सा, रे, ग, म, प, ध, नी। संगीत की प्राप्त के लिए व्यक्ति को शुरूआत में विधिवत तरीके से इसका अभ्यास करना होता है। कहा जाता है कि जितना प्रभाव संगीत में है उतना किसी तंत्र—मंत्र विद्या आदि में नहीं है। इसीलिए अच्छा संगीतज्ञ बनने के लिए साधक को गुरू शरण में रहकर संगीत साधना करनी होती है तभी वह संगीत के क्षेत्र में चमत्कारिक सिद्धि प्राप्त कर सकता है।
- 4. संगीत का प्रभाव तथा महत्व: संगीत शास्त्र में शुद्ध: कोमल एवं तीव तीन प्रकार के स्वर बताए गए हैं। इन्हीं स्वरों के विशेष स्वर संगति से रागों की उत्पत्ति होती है।

शास्त्रीय संगीत में विभिन्न प्रकार के राग है। इन रागों में वो चमत्कार है, अगर इन्हें सही तरीकें से साधा जाए तो इनका फल प्राप्त किया जा सकता है। जैसे-राग जयजयवन्ती से अग विकार वाले रोगी को लाभ होता है तथा राग कंदार से मानसिक रोगी ठीक होते है इसी प्रकार विभिन्न पादपों, फसलों आदि को मधुर संगीत सुनाया जाए तो इनके विकास में आश्चर्यजनक बृद्धि होती है। वहीं दूसरी ओर शोर-शराबा एवं घटिया आवाज, कड़वी आवाज इन्हें क्षति पहुँचाती है।

संगीत शास्त्र में जितना संगीत के विषय में बताया गया है उतना ही काफी नहीं इसका विषय क्षेत्र इतना व्यापक है कि कोई भी इसकी पूर्ण अभिव्यक्ति नहीं कर सकता। संगीत सम्राट तानसेन जी का नाम किसने नहीं सुना, कहा जाता है कि शाही दरबार में राग वीपक सुनाकर उन्होंने माहौल को अग्निमय बना दिया था। तब उनकी पुत्री ने राग मेघ मलहार गाकर तापमान को उण्डा किया था।

निष्कर्ष - अन्त में यही कहा जा सकता है कि संगीत एक ऐसा अथाह सागर है जिसकी कोई सीमा नहीं अर्थात् इसमें जितना अन्दर जाएंगे गहराई बढ़ती नजर आएगी। संगीत के विषय में एक रचनाकार कहते हैं -

> प्यार नहीं हैं स्वर से जिसको, वे मूरख इन्सान नहीं। जग में अगर संगीत ना होता, कोई किसी का मीत न होता।। ये एहसान है सात सुरों का, कि दनियाँ वीरान नहीं। प्यार

संगीत इन्सान को इन्सान से, प्रकृति से तथा संसार की हर वस्तु पदार्थं से जोड़े हैं। इसके बिना कुछ भी नहीं है। सब इसी से ही है।







FUTURE OPPORTUNITIES IN SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

There are many brilliant ideas for future. Humans have developed a map of future where we can live like heaven. Some of the future idea are:

- (1) Space Drones: NASA has challenged designers to develop a conventional drone to work inside a space station, navigating with no up or down.
- (2) 760 MPH Trains: Scientists are designing a train passengers travel at up to 760 MPH through a vacuum tube, propelled by compressed air and induction motors.
- (3) Coffee Power: Londons coffee industry creates over 200,000 tonnes of wastes every year so what do we do with it? Entrepreneur Arthur Kay's big idea is to use his company, bio-bean to turn 85 per cent of coffee waste into biofuels for heating building and powering transport.
- (4) Drown Forest Fires in Sound: Forest fires could one day be dealt by drones that would direct loud noises at the trees below. Since sound is made up of pressure waves, it can be used to disrupt the air surrounding a fire essentially cutting of the supply of oxygen to the fuel.
- (5) Space Balloon: If you want to take a trip to space,

your quickest bet might be to take a balloon. The company World View Enterprises wants to send tourists into the stratosphere (32 KM above Earth) on Hot Air Balloons

- (6) Breathalyser Cars: The U.S. Nation Highway Traffic Safety Administration has developed devices that car monitor Alcohol levels by sniffing a drivers breath or scanning the blood in their fingertips via the steering wheel, immobilizing the car if levels are too hìgh.
- (7) Personalities For Robots: Google has obtained a patent on robot personalities reminiscent of the Genuine People Personalities of robots in the Hitchhikers guide to the galaxy owner could have personality automatically choosen to match their needs or select one character from any Fiction or Fantasy or a loved one.
- (8) Human-Head Transplant: Sergio Canavero, a neurosurgeon attempted a human head transplant was possible but hope came in mind of Canavero. He explained that a human head transplant can be improved by a social blade and a polythene glycol.
- (9) Floating Farms: Some scientists are developing floating farms. Due to the increasing population and urbanisation farms cannot fulfil the increase demands of food by people. So Floating Farms can fulfil the demands of people as a single Floating Farm of 250*300M can produce 8.1 tones of vegetables and 1.7 tones of fish per year.

Conclusion: Intrinsic ecological values need to be recognized, including the greater community of life with which we share the planet and the need to maintain the evolutionary potential of life itself. It is never too late to interest children in science and once enthused, they will become a new generation with a crucially enhanced understanding of science.


