Students explored the ancient Badoli Temple Complex, consisting of nine temples constructed in the 10th and 11th centuries in the Kalatmak architectural style. These temples, dedicated to deities like Lord Shiva, Ganesha, Vishnu, Mahishasur Mardini, and Mataji, provided a fascinating glimpse into India's rich cultural heritage.

The most prominent temple, Ghateshwar Mahadev, captured everyone's attention with its unique architecture and history. This temple features:

Garbha Griha (Sanctum Sanctorum) Artha Mandapa (Intermediate Hall)

Rang Mandapa (Main Pavilion), famously known as Shringar Chowri

The temple is named after the ghat- or pot-shaped Shiva Linga, housed in its sanctum. Teachers also shared the historical account of Alauddin Khilji's attack, during which several idols were damaged, adding to the site's historical significance.

Recreational and Educational Activities




